In exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Lagos Local Government Law, 1953, as amended by the Lagos Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, the Governor-General, after consultation with the Council of Ministers, has made the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Lagos Town Council (Election Date) Order, 1959, and shall apply in respect of the Federal territory of Lagos.

2. The date of the next election of councillors to the Lagos Town Council shall be the 29th day of October, 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 15A (2) of the Lagos Local Government Law, 1953, as amended by Ordinance 35 of 1956, prescribes the 15th day of October, 1959, as the date for the next election of councillors to the Lagos Town Council, but section 40 provides that, if for any season the holding of the election on the date specified appears to be impracticable, a different date may be appointed (such date being subsequent but as near as possible to the date specified). Because details of the number and the distribution of qualified voters in Lagos have only recently become available, it has not been possible to make an earlier decision on the division of the town into wards and a re-allocation of seats. Sections 3 and 15 (3) of the Law provide that an Order to effect auch changes must be published at least three months before an election and it is therefore necessary to postpone the date of the election by two weeks.

Commencement : 27th July, 1959

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 153 of the Lagos Local Government Law, 1953, the Governor-General, after consultation with the Council of Ministers, has made the following Order-

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the List of Voters (Temporary Ameadment) Order, 1959, and shall apply in respect of the Faderal territory of Lagos.

(2) This Order shall expire on the 31st December, 1959.

2. During the currency of this Order rule 9 in the First Schedule to the Lagos Local Government Law, 1953, is amended by the insertion after paragraph (4) of the following—

"(4A) In respect of the triennial election to be held in the year 1959, the copies of the preliminary list shall be sent to the Returning Officer by such date before the election as may be prescribed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This is an amendment to the rules relating to Lagos Town Council elections and it modifies the requirement that copies of the preliminary list shall be sent to the Returning Officer at least 80 days before the election. The purpose of the amendment is to make it possible, if such a course is decided upon by the Federal Legislature, to utilise the Federal Electoral Register for the Lagos Town Council elections to be held on the 29th of October, 1959.

Lagos Town Council (Division into Wards and Allocation of Seats) Order, 1959

Commencement ; 27th July, 1959

In sxercise of the powers conferred by sections 3 and 15 of the Lagos Local Government Law 1953, as amonded by the Lagos Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, the Governor-General, after consultation with the Council of Ministers, has made the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Lagos Town Council (Division into Wards and Allocation of Seats) Order, 1959, and shall apply in respect of the Federal territory of Lagos, and in respect of any election to the Town Council held after the date of this Order.

2. (1) The town of Lagos is hereby divided into the forty-two wards the names of which are specified in the Schedule hereto.

(2) The boundaries of each such ward are specified in such Schedule under the name of each such ward.

3. It is notified that each ward specified in the Schedule shall be represented in the council by one councillor.

4. The Lagos (Division into Wards and Allocation of Seats) Order, 1956, and the Lagos (Division into Wards and Allocation of Seats) (Amendment) Order, 1959, are revoked.
